Thank you for your correspondence received 24 August 2022 in relation to Unexploded Ordnance clearance activities of the Moray West Offshore Windfarm. I can inform you that the conditions for issue of a licence have been met and a copy of the licence EPS/BS-00010032 is enclosed. You should quote the licence number should you require to contact us again regarding this matter.

I am obliged to draw your attention to the conditions contained within the licence, as detailed by our advisors. Under The Conservation (Natural Habitats, &c.) Amendment (Scotland) Regulations 2007, it is an offence to fail to comply with those conditions.

I also draw your attention to a condition that the Licensee must ensure that mitigation measures for high order detonation is implemented for low order deflagration and high order detonation methods.

You will note that the licence runs to 31 March 2023. If a new licence is required, it should be applied for before this licence expires to allow a possible extension rather than a complete new application.
