Thank you for your e-mail correspondence dated 16th December 2021 relating to the application and EIA submitted by **Staffin Community Trust (per Affric Ltd)** for the harbour development at Staffin Slipway, Isle of Skye.

Northern Lighthouse Board have no objection to the proposed harbour development and recommend the following:

- The entrance channel from Staffin Bay should be marked with three port and three starboard unlit lateral buoys and have the associated shape and/ or topmark fitted to each buoy.
- The end of the new breakwater should have an unlit port lateral pole with can shaped topmark at least 2 metres above the surface of the breakwater.
- Staffin Community Trust should issue local Notice to Mariners advising of the nature and duration
 of the works and as necessary throughout the project (copied to navigation@nlb.org.uk).
- The Statutory Sanction of the Northern Lighthouse Board must be sought prior to the installation or discontinuation of any AtoN, please contact navigation@nlb.org.uk
- On completion of the harbour development, a copy of the 'as built' plans along with details of the
 unlit buoys, unlit lateral pole and any revised water depths should be submitted to the UK
 Hydrographic Office (sdr@ukho.gov.uk) in order that the associated charts and publications can be
 updated.
