APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF SECTION 36 CONSENT GRANTED TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE NEART
NA GAOITHE OFFSHORE WIND FARM

Please treat this letter and the enclosed documents as an application under section 36C of the Electricity Act 1989 to vary the consent granted under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Limited on the 3 December 2018 ("the section 36 consent").

The section 36 consent authorises Neart na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Limited to construct and operate the Neart Na Gaoithe Offshore Wind Farm, an offshore wind turbine generating station located within the Firth of Forth with a maximum output of 450 MW, all as more fully described in Annex 1 (Description of The Development) to the section 36 consent.

This variation application seeks to make the following variations to the section 36 consent:

- removal of references to transmission infrastructure (i.e. offshore substation platforms, interconnector cables and offshore export cables) from the Description of the Development in Annex 1 and from conditions 12 and 22 of Annex 2;
- amendment of minimum blade tip clearance from 35 to 36 metres (measured from LAT); and
- amendment of blade width in Annex 1 from 4.5m to 5.5m.

A draft of the variations which it is proposed should be made to the section 36 consent, together with the reasons for the proposed variations, have been included in the section 36 consent variation report accompanying this letter.
