MS-LOT is satisfied that Beatrice Offshore Windfarm Limited ("BOWL") has now submitted sufficient evidence to notify, in writing of the Date of Completion of the Works and the Final Commissioning of the Work. MS-LOT confirms that no further action is required.

Details:

Beatrice offshore windfarm is a development in the Moray Firth made up of 84 wind turbines and associated offshore transmission works.

As part of conditions 3.2.4.1 and 3.2.4.3 of the OfTW Marine Licence (number: 04461/18/1), BOWL had no more than one month to notify MS-LOT in writing following the Date of Completion of the Works and of the date of the Final Commissioning of the Works to notify MS-LOT in writing of the completions.

On 11 July 2019, BOWL submitted a letter requesting MS-LOT discharge the conditions 3.2.4.1 and 3.2.4.3 of the OfTW Marine Licence ("discharge request letter") following the end of the construction period (Appendix A). In the discharge request letter, BOWL reported that the Date of Completion of the Works, when the section 2 completion certificate was issued was 20 July 2018, and the date of the Final Commissioning of the Works, which was formally approved by National Grid Electricity System Operator Ltd, was on 2 April 2019.

The discharge request letter was submitted nearly after a year of the Date of Completion of the Works and three months after date of the Final Commissioning of the Works. MS-LOT had not received any other notification from BOWL in regard to those dates, which lead to the breach of the aforementioned OfTW marine licence conditions.

MS-LOT on 21 October 2019, requested further clarification from BOWL on whether it had submitted a notification previously to those dates. On 22 October 2019, BOWL submitted a justification for the delays to MS-LOT. BOWL stated there was some internal discussion regarding what constituted Completion of the Works and Final Commissioning of the Works. BOWL also stated that some works on the OTMs were ongoing throughout summer 2019 and confirmed that it had not notified MS-LOT within one month of the Date of Completion of the Works and of the date of the Final Commissioning of the Works (Appendix A).

MS-LOT is satisfied that the discharge request letter has notified MS-LOT of the Date of Completion of the Works and the date of the Final Commissioning of the Works and with the evidence submitted to justify the notification delay. MS-LOT is of the opinion that even though the notification of the Date of Completion of the Works and of the date of the Final Commissioning of the Works was delayed, the evidence submitted is sufficient and there is no further action required.

Actions Taken by BOWL:

- BOWL submitted a discharge request letter on 11 July 2019 and notified MS-LOT of the Date of Completion of the Works and of the date of the Final Commissioning of the Works
- 2. BOWL submitted an email on 22 October 2019 to justify why the delay occurred.

You have submitted to Marine Scotland Licensing Operations Team (MS-LOT) a letter on 7 July 2019 requesting that condition 3.2.4.1 and 3.2.4.3 of BOWL's Offshore Transmission Works Marine Licence to be fully discharged.

In accordance with conditions 3.2.4.1 and 3.2.4.3 of the OfTW ML, this letter confirms the final completion and commissioning dates of the Works.


