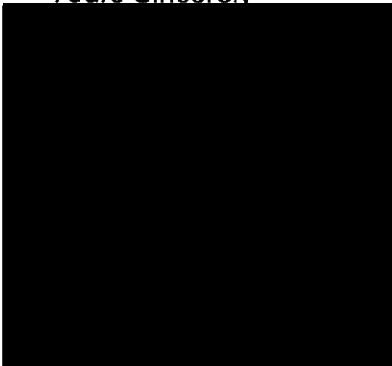
I am writing to confirm that North Highland College UHI would be pleased to support the Dounreay Tri Floating Wind demonstration project.
