Thank you for your consultation which we received on 09 May 2022 seeking our comments on an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) screening opinion for the above proposed development. This letter contains our comments for our historic environment interests. Under the Marine (Scotland) Act 2010 our historic environment interests cover Historic Marine Protected Areas (HMPAs) and undesignated marine cultural heritage features.

### **The Proposal**

We understand that this screening report is in support of an application for the temporal extension to the existing marine licence to allow capital dredging and construction work to continue. This will extend the marine licence by 3 years to July 2025.

### **Our Screening Opinion**

We previously noted in our response to the original marine licence application (Your ref. 06806 & 06807 06/12/2018) that the proposals were unlikely to have a significant impact on our interests. We are content that this advice remains appropriate for the current consultation and are therefore of the view that there are unlikely to be impacts on our historic environment interests of a level that would require consideration through the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) process.
