Thank you for your consultation which we received on 09 May 2022 seeking our comments on an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) screening opinion for the above proposed development. This letter contains our comments for our historic environment interests. Under the Marine (Scotland) Act 2010 our historic environment interests cover Historic Marine Protected Areas (HMPAs) and undesignated marine cultural heritage features.

The Proposal

We understand that this screening report is in support of an application for the temporal extension to the existing marine licence to allow capital dredging and construction work to continue. This will extend the marine licence by 3 years to July 2025.
