Protection zones should allow for interconnector

Marine protection and Isles' renewables

Concerns that a proposed new marine protected area (pMPA) in the Minch could hinder the development of future renewable energy projects, have been raised by the Comhairle.

In its response to Marine Scotland's consultation on the pMPAs in the Minch and the Sea of the Hebrides, the Comhairle has stated that development controls in the proposed area off north east Lewis should be designed to 'easily accommodate' any future upgrade of the electric inter-connector transmission cable, which will run on the seabed from Arnish in Lewis to the mainland, and to enable cables from any future off-shore wind farm developments off the north of

the Lewis to be laid across any newly designated protected areas.

In its response to the consultation, the Comhairle highlights that if the proposed inter-connector cable is limited to 450MWs 'it will be inevitable that the Transmission Owner will have to return within a few years to install a second underground and subsea cable'.

Barvas set to be test ground



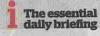
Three week bin collection plan

Comhairle nan Eilean Siar is set to trial a new three-weekly collection service for non-recyclable household waste bins, and to trial the introduction of new two-weekly collections for recyclable waste.

The pilot scheme will take place on the Barvas round and comes as the Comhairle looks to secure savings in its waste and recycling services as part of the service redesign process and from efficiency savings.

The trial was recommended in a report on the Comhairle's waste management and cleansing services that went before last week's Transportation and Infrastructure Committee, and which is set to be rubber-stamped by the Comhairle this week.

The move also comes in advance of the introduction of a ban on biodegradable municipal waste going to landfill, and the launch of the Scottish Government's Deposit Return Scheme, which, the Comhairle hopes, could have a 'positive impact' on waste and recycling collection and could net savings of up to £40k per year, and which are both set to begin in 2021.



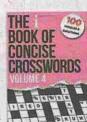

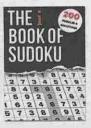

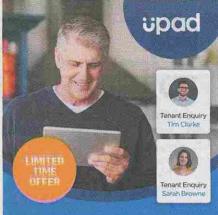
