# Budget woe as savings fall short oftarget

Comhairle nan Eilean Siar could be facing a 'significant' financial challenge in the coming year, if greater progress on its 'service redesign' process is not achieved.

The warning, given by the Comhairle's Director of As-

sets, Finances and Resources, to last week's meeting of the policy and resources committee, comes in the wake of an Audit Scotland (AS) report which claimed that only 40 per cent of the savings planned for through a 'service redesign' process had so far been secured, and stated that the Comhairle will need to look for 'alternative measures' to implement 'where targets are not achieved'

Agricultural Support

The AS report confirmed that the Comhairle's 2018/19 budget gap of £5.5 million was to be met by savings of £3.9 million 'and the use of £1.6 million of general fund reserves'.

£2m of the savings was to be met from the planned service redesign programme, but, according to AS, only £0.8m of this target has been achieved.



# Anti-poverty strategy launched

A new anti-poverty strategy for the Outer Hebrides was launched this week in Stornoway. The priority of the new strategy is to address poverty associated with low income from employment, the cost of living and income from benefits, and to place 'the real lived experience of poverty' in the Western Isles at the centre of the multi-agency approach. The new strategy, developed by the Outer Hebrides Community Planning Partnership, also incorporates the Local Child Poverty Action report of 2019 and will be delivered through the joint working of Comhairle nan Eilean Siar, NHS Western Isles and the Third STORY CONTINUES PAGE 5
