MARINE (SCOTLAND) ACT 2010 & THE MARINE LICENSING (PRE-APPLICATION CONSULTATION)(SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2013

Notice is hereby given that The North Ayrshire Council, Cunninghame House, Irvine, KA12 8EE, plans to hold a pre-application event regarding a proposed licensable marine activity at Millport seafront, Isle of Cumbrae. The activity consists of the construction of a coastal flood protection scheme.

The proposed **coastal flood protection scheme** includes rock armour breakwaters located offshore in Millport Bay, rock armour revetments and shore connected breakwaters located in the intertidal zone and works on land within the Millport seafront area. Temporary works may be required in the intertidal and subtidal zone on the east coast of Great Cumbrae, to enable material deliveries via a temporary slipway.

The pre-application consultation event will take place online due to Covid restrictions. The event will take place on 14th September 2021 from 5pm -7pm. The consultation event will provide an opportunity for the public and stakeholders to consider and comment on the prospective marine licence application. Paper copies of the questionnaire will be available from the Garrison House, Millport and a collection box will be provided for responses. The consultation will close on the **28**th **September 2021.**

Please note that comments made to North Ayrshire Council are not representations to the Scottish Ministers. When North Ayrshire Council submits the marine licence application there will be an opportunity for representations to be made to the Scottish Ministers on the application.
